#### **BANKING AND CURRENCY EXCHANGE**

The Italian monetary system is the Euro (€). Foreign currency can be exchanged at banks, currency exchange offices, hotels and at the airport upon presentation of an identification document. All major credit cards are accepted in most hotels, restaurants and shops.

#### THE CITY OF VENICE

The Italian city of Venice surely makes it onto every traveller's must-see list. It is a destination unlike any other, with a reputation for romance that surpasses even that of the Italian capital. Venice is a beautiful city on the northeast coast of Italy. The region enjoys a subtropical climate with long, hot summers and wet, cold winters. Autumn is often one of the best times to visit Venice because it's not too hot and temperatures are still very mild and agreeable.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

The main tourist area of Venice is entirely car-free, which is most conducive to romantic wanderings by the canal at twilight.

#### Main Vaporetto lines

The most useful water bus lines for tourists are the following:

Line 1: One of the most handy lines for all visitors is line 1. It slowly cruises the Grand Canal from the central bus station in Piazzale Roma until Venezia Lido. It stops in most landmarks down the Canal like Piazza San Marco, Ca'Rezzonico or Rialto Bridge; Line 3: connects Piazzale Roma and Murano; Line 7: connects Piazza San Marco with Murano; Line 10: is the quickest way to get from Piazza San Marco to Lido; Line 18: runs between Lido and Murano.

Schedule Usually, most lines that serve Venice run from 4:30 am until 12:30 am (midnight).
